Program Satisfaction

Graduate Survey 2015 (37% of program graduates report the following)

- 91.67% of program graduates would recommend the Atlantic Cape Community College Nursing Program to others.
- 100% of program graduates feel the Nursing Program gave them a strong knowledge base.
- 87.5% of program graduates are planning to pursue a BSN within the next year.

Employer Survey 2015 (13% of 2014 graduates)

- 100% of employer who responded rated program graduates' performance as acceptable – superior in the following areas – problem solving, communication, leadership, critical thinking, conflict management, interdisciplinary collaboration, professionalism, and currency of practice.

Alumni Survey 2015 (42% of program graduates report the following)

- 92.6% of program graduates feel the Atlantic Cape Nursing Program gave them a strong preparation for the NCLEX exam.
- 85% of program graduates have obtained employment in nursing within 1 year of program completion
- 82.61% of program graduates are employed **full time** in Nursing within 1 year of program completion
 - 63% of program graduates are employed in Acute Care (Hospitals)
 - 37% of program graduates are employed in either Long Term Care or Home Care
