**Program Learning Outcome 4:** Graduates, who desire employment, obtain entry level positions within 12 months of graduation.

**2016 Alumni Survey – secured in May 2017** (32% of program graduates completed the survey)

- 90% of program graduates have obtained employment in nursing within 1 year of program completion
- 44.44% of program graduates are employed full time in Nursing within 1 year of program completion
  - 75% of program graduates are employed in Acute Care (Hospitals)
  - 25% of program graduates are employed in either Long Term Care or Home Care

**Program Learning Outcome 5:** Graduates demonstrate the competencies of associate degree nurses at graduation and one year post-graduation as validated by employers.
